



## FIELD OPERATOR

### The Opportunity:

Under the general direction of the Supervisor, Operations and daily guidance from a Lead Operator in the Wolf Pipeline Business Unit, the Field Operator is responsible for the safe and efficient operation and maintenance of Wolf Midstream's assets.

**This is a full-time, permanent position based out of our Sturgeon terminal in Alberta. This position may service both the North and South operating areas. There is no relocation subsidy assigned for this role.**

### Key Responsibilities:

**1. 90% ~~ Provide safe and efficient operations and maintenance to assets by:**

- Start up and commissioning of pipeline and facilities;
- Operating and maintaining LACT's, Pump Stations and other field related facilities;
- Proactive inspection of Wolf sites for inefficiencies/deficient equipment, procedures or conditions and initiate corrective action;
- Identify abnormal operating conditions or operating conditions where emergency response is necessary. Determine corrective action and execute;
- Utilize the Computer Maintenance Management System (Avantis) to complete:
  - Work Orders
  - Purchase Requisitions
  - Work Requests
- Perform and or Supervise Pigging Activities as required;
- Activities as outlined in the PM programs;
- Product sampling and testing;
- Housekeeping on all sites and buildings;
- Understand and follow Wolf HSE Management System;
- Supervise third party contractors for safety and work quality;
- Communicate and cooperate with producers, shippers and receivers at the field level;
- Prepare and update, safe work procedures and operating procedures;
- Strive for efficient operation;
- Participate in emergency response training;
- Some travel will be required.

**2. 10% ~~ Other duties as assigned**

NOTE: Overtime and responding to call outs is required on an as needed basis.

### Education:

- Minimum of a high school diploma (trade or technical certification preferred).

### Experience:

- A minimum of 5 years oil field related experience with preference given to liquid pipelines;
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills to interact with stakeholders;
