



## Senior Health & Safety Advisor

### The Opportunity:

Under the direction of the Superintendent, Health, Safety and Training, this individual will be a dynamic member of the HS&T Team.

The Senior Health & Safety Advisor's primary function is to ensure the Wolf Midstream Pipeline Business unit is adequately prepared to carry out duties in a safe and prudent manner.

Compliance and relationship focus is essential to ensure that all applicable regulation, codes and practices are being addressed and maintained. A strong collaborative approach to implementation of programs or initiatives is essential in this role. This position must act as a strong resource for internal stakeholders to ensure optimal health and safety performance. This role is considered a primary point of contact, for coaching/mentoring on health & safety-related topics, along with providing directional focus and leadership. This position will work on a collaborative basis with operations and corporate teams to identify, resource, audit & resolve identified health & safety issues

This is a full-time permanent position based out of Fort Saskatchewan, Alberta. Expectations of this position will be 50% office related functions and 50% field interaction. Some overnight or extended travel will be required.

### Scope of Responsibilities:

- 1. 50% ~ Ensuring Field Operations are adequately prepared to carry out their duties:**
  - Ensuring the Safety Culture at Wolf aligns with our Core Values
  - Provide leadership, guidance, training, expertise, development and implementation of Health and safety Management programs to internal stakeholders and contractors.
  - Act as point of contact for local or provincial regulatory groups.
  - Participate and manage internal field audits and inspections.
  - Support the development of organizational health & safety objectives.
  - Provide project Health and Safety support for operational activities.
  - Act as coach/mentor/resource regarding safety issues to the Operations Leadership Team.
  - Conduct incident investigations and participate as an active member of incident investigation team.
  - Track and follow-up on outstanding Health & Safety issues providing continual communications on progress

  - Implement and maintain health and safety programs to ensure compliance with applicable regulations and standards.
  - Provide Health & Safety training resources to fulfill employee requirements.
  - Work with Operations in the stewardship of competency profiles of employees as to Health and Safety requirements.
  - Provide health & safety expertise for the Wolf Pipeline Business Unit

- Review contractor Health & Safety Programs and work with the Pipeline Business Unit to monitor for compliance with Wolf Midstream Health and Safety requirements.
- Maintain internal & external stakeholder Health and Safety contacts.
- Provide health & safety performance evaluation and reporting for the Pipeline Business Unit.
- Work with Pipeline Business Unit teams to coordinate the development of a Health & Safety structure and progressive program, measuring success and levels of improvement (gap analysis).
- Participate in Management System performance audits to ensure compliance with Wolf Pipeline Operating Procedures (AOP's) and regulatory requirements.

**3. 25 % ~ Health & Safety Goals & Objectives Planning:**

- Participate on behalf of the company, where required, in health and safety related activities and meetings. These activities will not be limited to but may include:
  - Joint Workplace Health and Safety Committee meetings.
  - Industry Health and Safety Committees (CEPA, Energy Safety Canada)
  - Tabletop exercises & emergency response using the Incident Command System.
  - Incident investigations
  - Facility inspections

**Knowledge/Skills/Education:**

- Relevant Post-Secondary Degree/Diploma or equivalent experience in Health and Safety

Required Experience:

- Minimum 10 years with a focus in Occupational Health and Safety in the oil & gas industry along with a related professional designation such as Canadian Registered Safety Professional.
- Strong understanding of regulatory requirements for applicable jurisdictions.
- Previous health and safety experience within an organization with a Certificate of Recognition, or similar, is preferred.
- Ability to effectively work within a group and problem solve.
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License, with a driver's abstract, promoting a safe driving record.
- Experience with Incident Management Software (VelocityEHS) and Learning Management Tools.
- Experience using the Incident Command System and Emergency Response Plans.
- Proficiency with Microsoft Office Suite (Word, Excel, and PowerPoint) is required.
